Praise the Lord Saints! Breast Cancer is preventable through proper screening. Per the NYC Department of Health, Breast Cancer kills 1260 women yearly. Self breast exams are to be performed monthly before menses due to hormonal breast changes; the same date monthly for post menopausal women. With the self breast exam you are looking for any discharge from the nipples. if the nipples are inverted and feeling for any lumps. Mammograms are to be performed yearly for women forty and over. For women under forty with family history and genetic markers for breast cancer, mammograms screening and monitoring are to be ordered and assessed per MD instructions. Men unfortunately are breast cancer candidates also and must be aware of any breast changes or discharge . Mammograms are free for qualified individuals without health insurance through NYC Health and Hospital Corporation; dial 311 and ask for mammogram. NYS services are offered through NYS Dept of Health Breast Cancer Programs the toll free number is 866-442- CANCER it provides cancer screening, diagnosis treatment and support services.
