He's Able.....

A few Sundays ago our Deacon Ambrose Darden made his lead debut with the Adult Choir. My God, the anointing fell and we were truly blessed. Pastor Johnson told us to hold on to that and how we would hear that song all week. The melody kept ringing in my heart and I felt good knowing that He Is Able. That Wednesday morning while taking a shower I literally heard the song... ♪ My God Will Do Just What He Said He Would Do, He Will Keep Every One Of His Promises To You...He's Able...♪ I turned the shower off and I realized it was my son Donovan, in his shower singing the song. Now the boy was singing loud enough for me to hear it over both of our showers and he's down the hall. As I walked down the hall to tell him to tone it down, he screamed out, "Mommy Pastor was right I was feeling that song all week..." and he kept right on singing. On the way to school he sang it, while doing his homework he sang it, now it's time for bed and he's still singing it. Enough already!!!! As I got out of my bed to tell him to knock it off, the scripture came to mind; St. Matthew 18: 1-4....

At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven? And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them, And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

We're so busy being grown, that we forget we're His children. A child depends entirely on their parents to meet all of their needs and doesn't think twice about it. When they are tired they know a place to rest has been provided, when they're hungry or just want a snack straight to the kitchen they go without a second thought. They skip, jump, play and sing because Mommy and Daddy "Are Able." In the hallway that night, God reminded me

Hebrews 13:17 ...*Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.*

The Lord has laid it on our Pastor's heart for us to go into the New Year Fasting. Let's be obedient. A 21 Day Fast has been declared. Days 1-7 fasting until 6pm everyday. Days 8-14 eating for only 1 hr/ day and Days 15 -21 drinking only water. We will pray without ceasing. Missionary Monroe has committed herself to be at the church every morning at 6am for those who wish to pray before starting the day, Deacon Monroe everyday at 12 noon for those who are able to come and we will all come together corporately at 8pm every night to pray.

Remember some things come out through prayer and fasting. We all have things before the Lord and some of those things if God doesn't help us, there is no help. He is a God that is true to his word. He will look out for children.

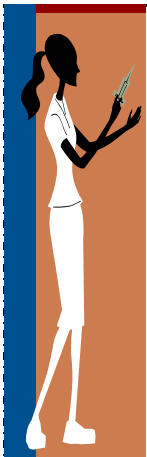

Healthcare Insurance is needed by everyone because an illness can wipe out savings and devastate a family. NYS does offer free and low cost health insurance programs. One such, is Affinity Health Plan, which offers Childhealth Plus for individuals 19 years of age and younger. Services include MD, dental, hearing, eye care and immunizations. Affinity also offers Family Health Plus for individuals 19 years to 64 years old which services physicals, lab tests, xrays, maternity, dental, eye and emergency care. This is available to everyone in NYC, Westchester, Nassau, Rockland and Orange counties. There are income eligibility parameters. Contact information is toll free number 866-206-1775.
